Bob Kaufman	has been involved with Crown during the Recreation Center and was an owner's
	representative during that time. He has always wanted to be on the board and is
	currently on the Mid Valley Metro board where he has missed maybe two meetings in
	ten years. He is currently a president of an HOA board. He loves the park and would like
	to be more involved to help take the park to the next level.
David parker	was involved with developing the design charettes to start the park and has been
	around almost as long at Leroy. He is currently a president of the Basalt Lions Club. His
	philosophy is "Nothing really stays the same". Things are increasing or deteriorating. He
